

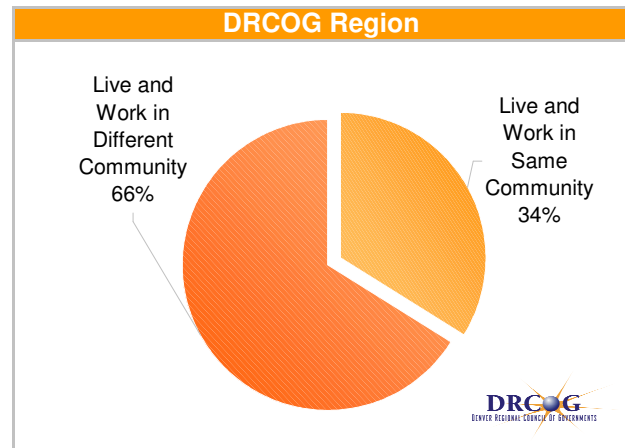
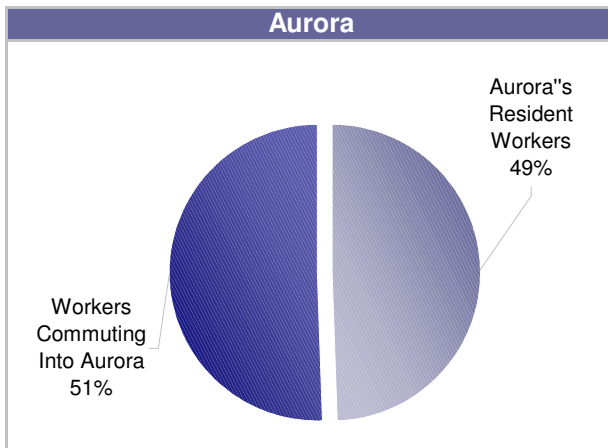
Workforce Commuting Patterns: City of Aurora

The movement of people and freight around the Denver region generates over 6 million car and truck trips on any given day. The following report summarizes workforce commuting patterns for municipalities within the DRCOG region. The data are drawn from the Census Transportation Planning Package (CTPP), part of the decennial Census of 2000. The CTPP provides tabulations of households, persons and workers. It summarizes information by place of residence, by place of work, and for worker-flows between home and work.
